

**Job Title:** Suspended Scaffolding Operator/Rigger Technician

**Job Summary:** Operates and rigs suspended scaffolding in a safe manner in accordance with regulatory and manufacturer's recommendations.

This is a travel position. Qualified candidates will travel to sites throughout the United States and Canada to expedite the rigging and operation of the suspended platforms.

*Key Responsibilities*

- Fastens slings, shackles and wire ropes to approved anchoring structures
- Sets up platforms, hoists and bloc stops for suspended scaffolding procedure
- Performs daily safety inspections of rigging and access equipment
- Ensures personal fall arrest systems is utilized correctly
- Recognizes hazards associated with suspended scaffolding (electrical hazards, changing weather conditions, falling object hazards, etc.)
- Exhibits courteous behavior with respect to customers, supervisors and coworkers
- Performs other duties as related to the position

*Job Requirements*

- Must be able to work in confined spaces
- Must be able to climb a 300 foot vertical ladder
- Ability to work at high elevations
- Ability to follow written and oral instructions
- Ability to lift up to 70 lbs. unassisted
- Ability to bend, kneel, climb, squat
- Must be able to read, write and speak English
- Ability to use hand power tools
